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M31 Reports Third Quarter EPS of NT\$-0.18

HSINCHU, Taiwan, R.O.C., November. 5, 2025 – M31 (TWSE: 6643) today announced consolidated revenue of NT\$355 million, net income of NT\$-7.48 million, and diluted earnings per share of NT\$-0.18 for the third quarter ended September 30, 2025.

Year-over-year, third quarter revenue decreased by 7.1%, while both net income and diluted EPS swung to a loss. Compared to second quarter 2025, third quarter results represented a 21.0% decrease in revenue but net income after tax improved, with the loss narrowing. All figures were prepared in accordance with TIFRS on a consolidated basis.

In US dollars, third quarter revenue was \$11,805 thousands, which slightly decreased 0.4% year-over-year and decreased 19.8% from the previous quarter.

Gross margin for third quarter was 100.0%, operating margin was -13.7%, and net profit margin was -2.1%.

In the third quarter, 2-8nm process accounted for 20.1% of total license revenue; 12-16nm process contributed 23.6% of total license revenue; 22-28nm process represented 24.9% of total license revenue. Overall, advanced nodes (including 16 nm and below) were the main contributors to license revenue, making up 43.7% of the total, followed by the 22-28nm process.

In terms of revenue breakdown, license fees accounted for 78% of total revenue in the third quarter, while royalties accounted for 22%. By region, the China market contributed 41.4%, North America 16.6%, Taiwan 33.8%, and other regions 8.1% of third-quarter revenue. By customer type, fabless customers made up 41.7% of the revenue, while foundry customers accounted for 58.3%.

M31 Technology CEO Scott Chang stated that the company is currently at a critical stage of technological transformation and organizational adjustment. As challenges in adopting advanced process technologies intensify, short-term profitability has been affected, for which the company expresses its sincere apologies. He noted that starting in 2026, expense growth will be kept within 10% annually, and through rigorous cost management and R&D integration, the company will continue to enhance



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operational efficiency and optimize resource utilization. Scott Chang further stated that M31 will continue to deepen its collaboration with global advanced foundries, strengthen its IP technology advantages below the 6-nanometer node, and steadily expand its presence in the mature process market to ensure a balanced product portfolio over both the short and long term. He emphasized, "The company remains committed to its 2025 goal of achieving 20% revenue growth in U.S. dollar terms and will continue to advance steadily in technological innovation, operational resilience, and royalty growth."
